Dear Neighbors,

Somerdale Park School's long awaited Parking Lot Project began construction on October 6, 2021. Three years ago the community voted and the Somerdale Board Education approved the following Bond Referendum projects: Replace 100% of the school's roof, upgrade the outdoor activity area (playground) and install a new parking lot. Two out of the three projects are complete, with the final and third project, the parking lot starting yesterday October 6, 2021.

Below are a few key points of interest regarding the project and construction:

- The tree contractor began removing trees from the school's property yesterday October 6, 2021.
- During our meeting, there were concerns regarding trees being removed from the proposed and existing natural tree line of the project. After inspecting the project this morning, no trees in the assigned buffer area were removed. We will reiterate to the tree contractor that the trees in this area are not to be removed.
- Work is scheduled from 7:00-4:00pm Monday through Friday.
- Work will not be scheduled on November 25<sup>th</sup>
- Estimated completion date for the project is December 31, 2021
- Various Construction vehicles will be present every day throughout the duration of the Parking Lot Project.
  - o Log cutter and mover
  - o Milling Machines
  - o Excavator
  - Bulldozer
  - o Distributor Tanks
  - Dump Trucks
  - Machine Pavers
  - Asphalt Compactors
  - o Pickup trucks
- We are currently researching the ownership of the vacant land parallel and between the Crestwood residents and Somerdale Park School property lines.
